INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The primary objective of the Mirae Asset ESG Asia Great Consumer Equity Fund ("the Fund") is to achieve long term growth in the share price through capital appreciation, measured in US Dollars, of the underlying equity portfolio which promotes environmental, social and governance (ESG) criteria. The Principal Investment Manager will seek to achieve the objective of the Fund by investing mainly in equities and equity related securities of Asian companies which are expected to benefit from growing consumption activities of Asian region, excluding Japan. The Fund promotes environmental, social and governance characteristics and is thus classified as a financial product falling within the scope of Article 8 of the SFDR.

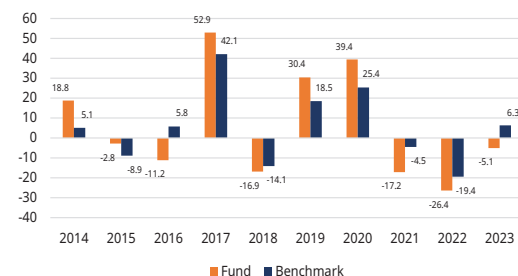

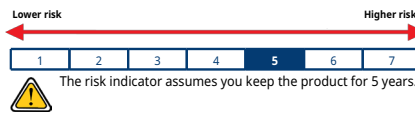
